Mackintosh's Toffees

The following information should start you on your journey into the past

Toffee Town was the popular name for Halifax because of the strong influence that Riley's toffee and Mackintosh's toffee had on life in the town. John Mackintosh & Sons Limited Confectionery company was founded in Halifax in 1890 by John Mackintosh and his wife, Violet. John Mackintosh was born in 1868 and died aged 51 in 1920. He was known as The Toffee King. He went into partnership with his wife Violet to open a pastry cook's shop in King Cross Street and went on to found the Mackintosh family's confectionery business.

In 1969, the company merged with Rowntree's of York to become Rowntree-Mackintosh PLC, and in 1988 they merged with Nestlé

The most famous name of all the Macintosh sweets is Quality Street
