The following information should start you on your journey into the past

A country woman on horseback passed the Gibbet while an execution was taking place.

At her sides were large wicker baskets.

When the head of the victim was chopped off, the force of the axe caused the head to bounce towards the woman.

Another report said that the head grabbed her apron with its teeth and stayed there for some time.
